A small school with BIG results***



Established in 1896 as a school for Spanish speaking boys from the Pueblos in northern New Mexico, around Albuquerque, its makeup has changed - the school has been coed since the thirties and has gone from a boarding school to a day-to-day school, although boarding is still available. Presbyterian sponsored from the beginning, it is now known for diversity, development of leadership, high moral standards, and Christian values. In addition, the class size is about ten students to one teacher. The school is proud of the high percentage of graduates who go on to college, 95%! Schools that have accepted Menaul boys and girls range from Austin College and ASU to Stanford and Harvard (in the last five years). Faith Church gives a portion of the Christmas Offering to the school and the Mission Committee includes them in its annual budget. In addition, there is a scholarship program and gifts from individuals are welcome.
