This is the final PW event until Fall so let's make it a great one!

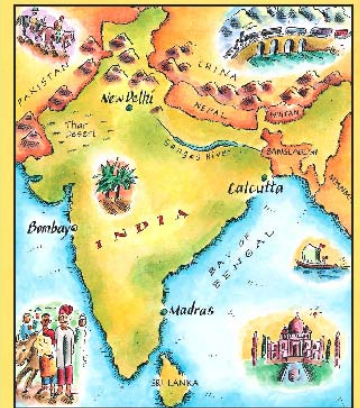
