## **Sermon Series for the Lenten Season -- 2010**

The hymn *“Jesus Calls Us”* will be the focus of our Sunday worship during Lent. For the six Sundays of Lent, Pastor Dave is following the Lectionary texts from the Gospel of Luke and the general theme of *Jesus Calls Us* (Red hymnbook, #269). The stories from Luke’s Gospel are some of the most memorable texts from the Bible.

Lent is a season of special devotion, reverence and commitment for all Christians. It is a period when we often set aside time for special study and reflection on our devotion and calling as disciples and followers of Jesus. It is a time when in the life of our congregation many will be seeking a deeper understanding of personal self-worth and faithfulness as a believer.

### **The Sixth Sunday in Lent (Palm Sunday) March 28**

*“As he was now approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the deeds of power that they had seen, saying, ‘Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in the highest heaven!’”*
